SOCIAL MEMBERS FEES FOR 2017

SOCIAL MEMBERS Bronze \$5.50 Silver \$15 Gold \$25

Social Members shall be entitled to the social privileges and advantages of the Club as the Board may deem from time to time and shall:

- a. Have the same voting rights as Golf and Bowls Members
 - b. NOT be entitled to use any sporting facilities without the payment of the appropriate fees
 - c. NOT be entitled to nominate for or be elected to the Board; and
 - d. NOT be entitled to propose, second or nominate any eligible member for any office of the Club or Life Membership of the Club
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PLEASE NOTE

1. New Applications must be received **IN PERSON FROM THE PERSON** making the application for membership.
New Applications received via the post or made by another person apart from the applicant will not be accepted.
 2. All details requested must be completed before this Application for Membership can be processed.
 3. Details on the application will be verified against the applicant's official identification upon receipt, including checking the signature, address and birth date.
 4. This document will be a tax invoice for GST purposes when you make payment.
 5. Money must accompany all applications. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, eftpos or credit card.
 6. Persons who have applied for membership of the Club are admitted as provisional members. Such persons shall have "immediate" full rights of the membership category sought.
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PRIVACY POLICY

The Murray Downs Golf & Country Club is subject to the provisions of the Privacy Act 1988. The Privacy Act 1988 (Privacy Act) contains 13 (updated and effective as of 12th March 2014) Australian Privacy Principles (APPs), which regulate the handling of personal information. The Club has a commitment to privacy and the safeguarding of member, visitor and staff personal information.

Any personal information provided by you to the Club will be protected.

We collect personal information directly from you, and only to the extent necessary to deliver and ensure a Club product, service or for compliance. We may choose to collect personal information from you when you fill in an application form in hard copy format. Also when you register online or over the telephone. We will always attempt to collect personal information from you using lawful and fair means, and not in an unlawful manner. The type of personal information we may collect from you generally comprises name, address, gender, contact details (including phone, fax and e-mail). Your details will not be provided to overseas recipients unless required by law.

The Club does not usually disclose your personal information to any other organisation or person unless there is a legal requirement to do so. The Club may also disclose personal information to relevant authorities if it reasonably believes that there is a threat to an individual's life, health or safety, or public health or safety. If the Club has reason to suspect that unlawful activity has been, is being or may be engaged in, personal information may be used or disclosed as a necessary part of any investigation and reporting to relevant persons or authorities.

The Club may disclose your information to third parties that provide services under contract to the club. These contracts require the third party to keep your personal information confidential and secure.

In the interest of safety for our members, guests and visitors, The Club has installed a network of CCTV cameras. Relevant footage is provided to the Police upon specific requests and is subject to a procedure where the request is identified.

All complaints will be taken seriously and dealt with appropriately by the Club's privacy office. Your personal information may be used by the Club for marketing purposes to improve our services or if there is a need to contact you;

by Officers of the Club (as defined in the constitution)

by elected representatives of golfing committees

by senior administrative staff

You have a right to access any personal information that the Club may hold about you, including a right of correction of your information. The Club will generally not charge a fee for you to access your personal information. The Club will, upon your request, and subject to applicable privacy laws, provide you with access to your personal information held by us.
